- Activities like click-o-math was introduced and implemented to ease and enhance learning atmosphere.
- Every special day was celebrated with a theme of skill development. Competing and showcasing the skills.

We are going to continue these good initiatives introduced during pandemic and further take many such initiatives for enhancing the learning of students (academic & non academic), measuring their performance (academic & non academic), communication with stake holders, our digital journey etc.

There were three rounds - written round, buzzer round and questioning round. Every question carried one mark each and there were time constraints for each round. The Main objective of the quiz was to encourage children to look beyond their textual knowledge and relieve the tension of their daily work routine. Children had a good team spirit wherein “small to big” all students were busy and giving tough fight to make their team win.



Experience says learning mathematics can be made easier and enjoyable if our curriculum includes mathematical activities and games. Maths Quiz encourages, attracts, alerts and brings in an open-minded attitude among youngsters which helps them to develop clarity in their thinking.



## CLICK O" MATH ABSTRACT



The aim of mathematics: A very short introduction is to explain, carefully but not technically, the differences between advanced, research-level mathematics, and the sort of mathematics we learn at school. It offers readers an insight into such seemingly paradoxical concepts as infinity, imaginary numbers, and curved space. The first few chapters are concerned with general aspects of mathematical thought and are followed by chapters on more specific topics such as limits and infinity, dimension, geometry, and estimates and approximations. It concludes with some answers to common sociological questions about the mathematical community. Our students have participated in click o math with lots of interest, confidence and practice. Teachers after teaching the chapter and does the revision by giving them worksheets and even we conducted a competitive spirit by conducting click o math by posting a problem and the children those who have done the solution fast and correct and posted in the online classes were awarded with prizes (certificates and shields). This made the children show more interest and solve the problems.

The idea of knowing the interest of our students in making food kept us dumbstruck with proved talent.



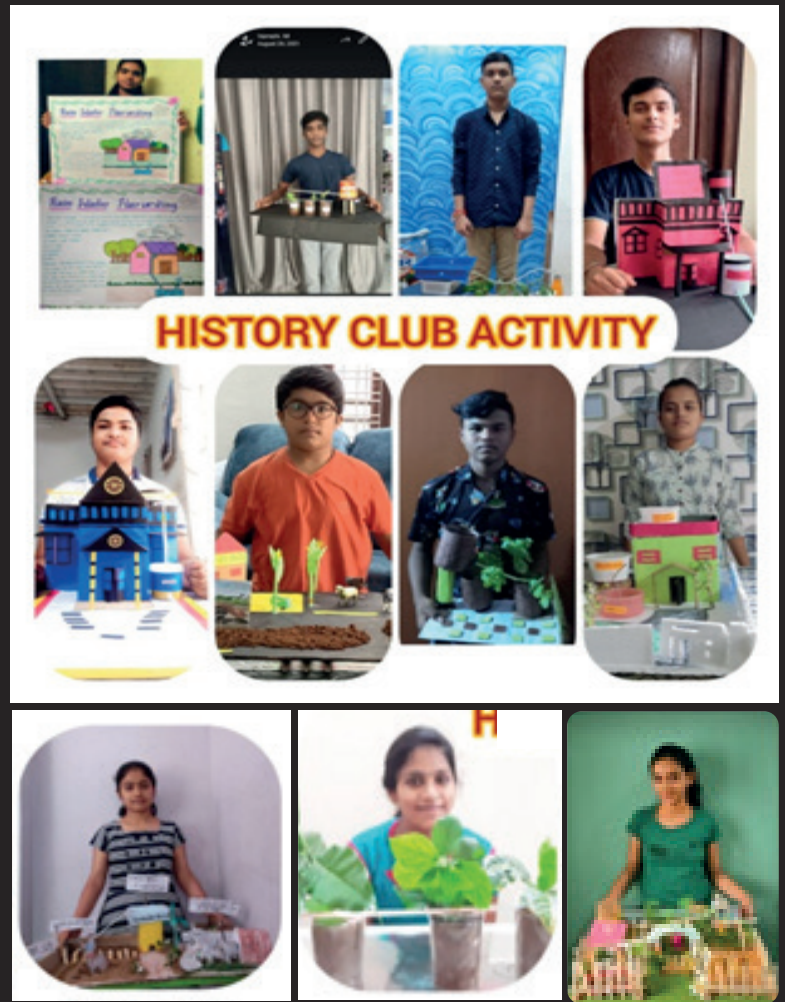
All in all admittedly, there are certain benefits to mastering cooking while young, such as being able to help one's parents, becoming more responsible and mature.

# PRE-PRIMARY



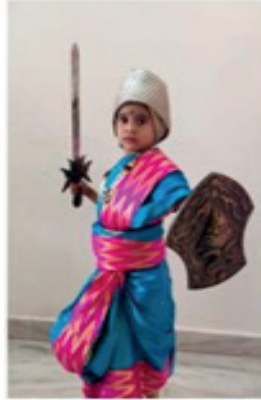

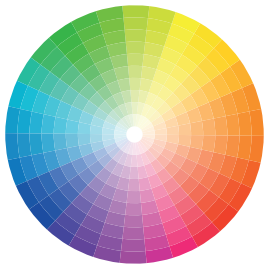


## GANESHA MAKING ACTIVITY

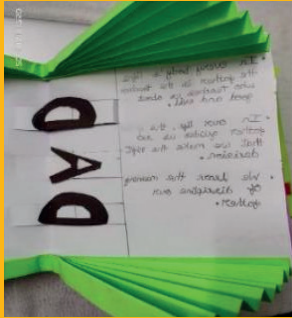


## FATHER'S DAY

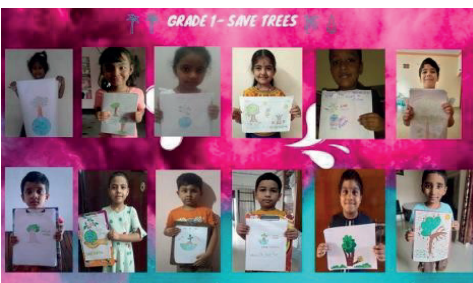

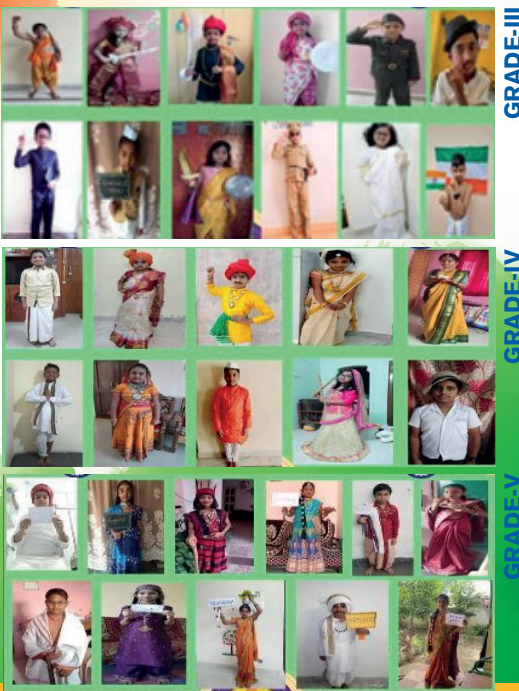

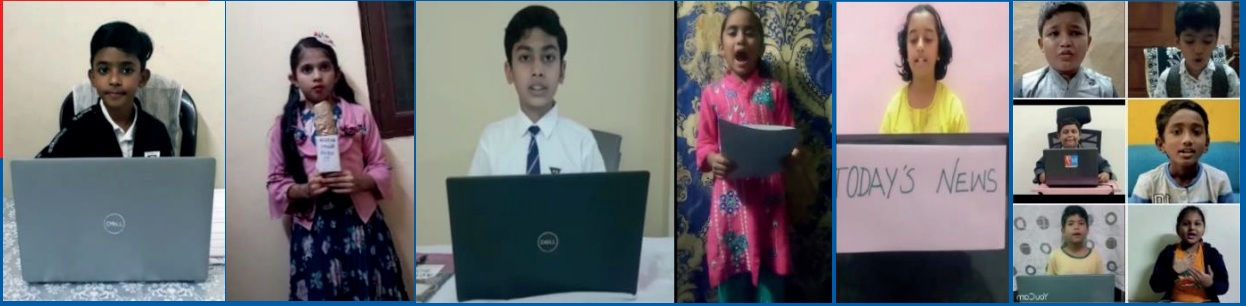
## Children's Day

Children's Day celebrated in an auspicious manner in our campus. Dance Programmes, Rampwalk, Music Shows, Skits etc held.



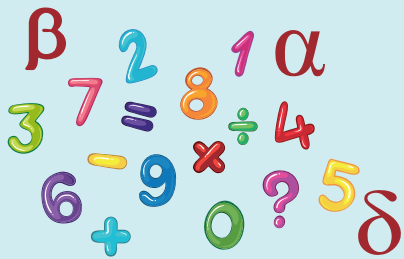
## NATIONAL JOURNALISM DAY
